## Hours of Operation

Downtown Cary Park is open daily from 7:00am-11:00pm

### GUEST SERVICES' HOURS

**January-March:** Monday-Saturday: 10:00am-6:00pm and Sunday: 1:00pm-6:00pm

**April-December:** Monday-Saturday: 9:00am-8:00pm and Sunday: 1:00pm-6:00pm

*Guest Services will be closed for all holidays.*

## DCP Transportation & Parking

There is an accessible parking deck located behind the Cary Regional Library with parking available. Additionally, parking is available in the lot on Charlie Gaddy Lane, at labeled street parking, and at the Town Hall Deck.

We have a drop off/pick up location located next to the Park on S Walker Street for buses to unload kids. Contact Morgan McGee at [morgan.mcgee@carync.gov](mailto:morgan.mcgee@carync.gov) to identify bus parking options in downtown Cary.

## DCP Rules & Regulations

### GENERAL

- All Cary ordinances, policies and procedures will apply.
- Your Group Leader is responsible for communicating and enforcing all rules and guidelines to guests and vendors participating in your visit.

Safety guidelines prohibit . . .

- Glass containers and outside alcohol.
- Riding skateboards, skates, scooters, rollerblades, bicycles or motorized recreational vehicles inside the Park.
- Entering planting beds, ponds, and fountains.
- Allowing your pet to be off leash outside the Barkyard.
- Excessive amplified sound or noise
- Defacement of Park property
- Smoking in indoor spaces.
- Littering of any kind.
- Weapons of any kind unless permitted by law.
- Driving poles, stakes or flags into the ground.
- Grilling, cooking or open flames.
- Confetti, glitter, silly string, pinatas, party poppers or streamers.

- Erecting tents or structures without a permit or permission of Park staff.
- Photography and filming of moderate to high impact as defined by the Cary's Film/Video/Photography Guide. This level of photography and film must be scheduled in advance with Park staff.

### THE NEST

- Children must be supervised by a responsible adult at all times.
- Be aware that some surfaces may be hot.
- Play at your own risk.
- Be kind and play nicely together. No rough play.
- Any person violating rules may be required to leave The Nest area.

### SPLASH PADS

The Splash Pad operates daily 9 a.m.– 8 p.m. from mid-May through mid-September. *Splash Pad availability is weather dependent. You must exit with any sign of thunder, lightning, or severe weather.*

For the safety & enjoyment of everyone . . .

- No lifeguard on duty. Use at your own risk.
- No running or rough play.
- Swimsuits and/or appropriate attire must be worn at all times.
- Swim diapers must be worn by children who are not potty trained.
- No pets, wheeled toys, food, drink, glass containers, gum or candy allowed in the Splash Pad area.
- No soaps, detergents or shampoos allowed.
- Do not drink the splash pad water.
- Any person violating rules may be required to leave the Splash Pad area.

## Emergencies

### GENERAL

For any life threatening emergencies, please call 911. You may also call the non-emergency Cary police number (919) 469-4012. Park Ambassadors are our on-site staff and may be reached at (919) 653-7180 during Guest Services hours.

### FIRST AID KITS

Large and portable first aid kits are located throughout the Park. They can be found at Market 317, The Bark Bar, and Guest Services.

First Aid Kits will include first aid supplies, ice packs that activate, and zip-lock bags to make ice packs. Ice can be obtained from Market 317, The Bark Bar, and Guest Services.

### **DEFIBRILLATOR (AED)**

AEDs are located throughout the Park: Academy Pavilion, Bark Bar, Gathering House, Nest Restrooms, and Guest Services.

### **SEVERE WEATHER**

Severe weather notifications will be communicated on the kiosks in the Park, social media, and our website.

#### **Severe Thunderstorm**

- If hail, strong winds, and lightning are present, Park Staff will ask visitors to return to their vehicles to wait out the storm
- Staff will also open additional available building for visitors to shelter in place
- Lightning within 10 miles will suspend all activities and events. Activities and events are safe to resume when there are no more storms inbound nearby and there has been no lightning within 10 miles for 30 minutes.

#### **Tornadoes**

- Tornado Watch – staff will require visitors to evacuate and return home ahead of the storm.
- Tornado Warning – staff will instruct visitors to specific buildings to shelter in place.

### **CARTS**

The Park features different activity carts for all to enjoy. Below are the carts you may see during your visit to the Park!

#### **Reading**

Our Reading Cart is a page-turning paradise for everyone. The Reading Cart is located primarily at Academy Plaza and will feature children's books, young adult novels, novels, graphic novels, dress up items, and much more. Grab a book, find a cozy spot, and let the stories take you on a journey!

We have 2 Fit & Play Carts in the Park. One Fit & Play Cart is located at Park Street Courts with supplies for ping pong, foosball, putt putt, badminton, lawn bowling, and more. The second Fit & Play Cart will be located in other parts of the Park to ensure active play is just a step away. This cart holds items such as hula hoops, jump ropes, soccer balls, footballs, and other fun items.
